Memorandum of Understanding
Pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998

1. Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between the Region 2 Workforce Investment Board, Worksystems, Inc., Multnomah and Washington Counties, the City of Portland and the following organizations: Home Forward, Housing Authority of Washington County, Labor's Community Services, Mt. Hood Community College, Northwest Oregon Labor Council, Oregon Department of Human Services which includes the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Oregon Employment Department, Oregon Human Development Corporation, Portland Community College, SE Works, and Springdale Job Corps.

2. One Stop Services

One Stop services to be provided are: Core, Intensive and Training services as described in the Workforce Investment Act of 1998. All Core services and many Intensive services are made available at each WorkSource Center in the Region. Referral to additional Intensive services and all Training services is available at each WorkSource Center.

Core services available at all WorkSource Centers include:

- Eligibility determination for WIA Title I Services
- Outreach, intake, and orientation to the information and services available through the WorkSource Portland Metro delivery system
- Initial assessment of skills and need for support services
- Unemployment Insurance information
- Labor Market information
- Help in establishing eligibility for the State's JOBS program and Financial Aid
- Job Search and placement assistance and career counseling, where appropriate
- Information relating to the availability of support services
- Performance outcome and cost information on Eligible Training Providers
- Information on how the local area is performing on local performance measures
- Follow-up services

3. Cost of Services

The costs associated with the provision of the above services and the operating costs of the system will be funded with Federal WIA dollars. At WorkSource Centers where multiple partners reside and share in the delivery of the services, a cost allocation methodology consistent with relevant OMB circulars will be determined as appropriate for the partners' service delivery plan.

4. Referral Methods between One Stop Operator and Partners

All Core services are made available at each WorkSource Center. Referrals to other services are made by phone call.

5. Amendment

Written amendments to this MOU may be made upon consensus of the partners and shall become effective on or after state approval of the amendment to the agreement.

6. Duration

This Agreement remains in effect until amended or replaced as agreed by all parties
